
The Common Room is a special place for inventions, making and creating. It is home to some of the world's famous engineers!

This is your chance to become a detective and investigate each section of the exhibition. Look out for our engineering superheroes for interesting facts!








2 Are dinosaurs older than coal?




3 Coal is a fossil fuel. What are two other types of fossil fuels?
