

Covid 19 Pre-visit Compliance Statement Valid from May 12th 2021 until further notice

We want to ensure all staff, visitors and contractors attending The Common Room are safe.

When you arrive on site you will be asked to sign in, in doing so this confirms your agreement to the following.

You do not need to send this form back to us prior to your visit.

We reserve the right to refuse entry to any individual who is not willing to comply with the following.

COVID-19 Measures

On attending The Common Room you confirm that:

- You, nor any member of your household, are not experiencing any covid-19 symptoms
- You have not been in close contact (less than 2m, more than 15 mins) with anyone with covid-19 symptoms in the last 7 days
- You have not been in close contact with anyone who has been diagnosed with covid-19
- If you, or a member of your household, or person for whom you have caring responsibilities; has been classified by the Government as high risk due to preexisting medical conditions that you will review government and/or medical guidelines prior to visiting The Common Room.

Additional Information

- Please note, pens, supplies and refreshments will not be provided onsite, please provide your own.
- You will be required to wear a facemask during your visit, and we will ask you to sign in and out on your arrival and departure.
- You may be asked to enter and exit through different doors.
- LRF flow tests are not mandatory for visitors, however, if you have had a
 negative LRF test result within 48 hours of your site visit there is a box on the
 sign in form to tick to confirm this.
